Why testing?

- Evaluate attention, concentration, memory, language, visual-spatial abilities, sensory-motor functions, general intellect, academic skills, and executive functioning (organization, problem-solving, and planning)
- Determine neuropsychological/cognitive deficits that interfere with school or work performance
- Identify cognitive strengths, abilities and learning style to enhance academic success
- Assist with school accommodations for your child
- Make recommendations regarding social and learning environments for your child
- Pre-operative psychological evaluations for gastric surgeries

What can testing assess?

- Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Emotional Disorders
- Learning Disabilities
- Cognitive Disorders
- ADHD
- Dementia
- Developmental Delays

What does testing entail?

- Non-invasive process that gives valuable information not provided by MRI's or other scans
- Typically takes 4 – 6 hours over one to two appointments
- An interview and administration of standardized tests, typically with paper and pencil
- Results and recommendations provided verbally and in a written report
