In addition to helping a child understand and complete school assignments, therapeutic tutoring allows the student to share and address any experiences, thoughts, and feelings which may contribute to their academic difficulties. The combination of both therapeutic and tutoring approaches can significantly increase motivation, confidence and perseverance while lessening anxiety and other emotional barriers to learning.

Key Responsibilities:

- Apply the Smart Love[™] approach in order to address the student's academic, social, and emotional challenges
- Establish the goals of therapeutic tutoring with students and parents
- Plan creative activities that reinforce what students learn in school and assist students in completing schoolwork/homework
- Acknowledge the student's effort and their willingness to share their difficulties
- Provide caring reflections and encourage the student to rely on the therapeutic tutoring relationship
- Build trust and rapport with students
- Communicate with parents and teachers
- Participate in orientation training and ongoing support and supervision
- Complete notes and other written documents accurately and on a timely basis

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Graduate degree (or pursuing) required in at least one of the following programs: education, special education, early childhood education, or a related field
- Classroom teaching or tutoring experience required
- Openness to learning and applying the Smart Love™ model
- Warm, friendly, and fun personality
- Ability to work after-school hours, nights, and/or Saturday mornings
- Excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to follow through and keep current with notes and other written documents.
