Busy, Busy Bees! Our 'Playschool' program for 2s & 3s is a hit!

As soon as the front door opens every morning children sprint to their classroom excited to discover what new and fun things they will learn and do that day. And, as one parent put it, "What a fantastic beginning to their school experience!"

Children easily engage with their teacher discovering sand table tea parties, "tape" floor streets, picture book readings, Magna-Tile and block structures, dress-up clothes, and so much more. Classroom activities are designed to stimulate their curiosity and foster exploration. With teachers' consistent, supportive responses and encouragement each 2-3 year old feels ready to branch out and explore new things. With each new step, our toddlers are more confident and competent in the classroom. This in turn makes coming to school enjoyable and exciting for them.

Learning about community is also a key feature of "Playschool." A wonderful example is snack time, when all the children come together and learn about each other. Something that the children love to do during snack time is listen to the sound of each other's pretzel crunch. "Do you

want to hear my crunch?" they ask as everyone leans in to hear. Each child takes a turn and the others patiently wait for their turns! By having fun while "taking turns", the children discover for themselves how good it feels to be heard and to hear others.

The Smart Love approach to early childhood education creates a positive school experience with a gentle separation process, making the transition to school so much easier and enjoyable for parents and children alike. We familiarize the children with a routine and activities similar to the preschool but age-appropriate for a 2-3 year-old. We also offer classes for children under 2 and their parent/caregiver.

Since our doors opened in October, the number of families coming to Smart Love has been steadily growing as word is spreading. Children's Garden Planted and Growing!

For the past eight years, the Natalie G. Heineman Smart Love Preschool has integrated a gardening and nature curriculum into its early childhood education program, and it has become one of the most beloved aspects of the preschool. With organic gardens planted and tended by the children, the teachers offer abundant opportunities for play-based experiences to enrich learning in an environmentally conscious context.

Our gardener-in-residence works with each classroom teacher to develop lesson plans and activities that are meaningful to the children. The gardener also manages the garden and leads many of the activities. Handson learning in the garden and the season-extending greenhouse as well as in the classroom (e.g. seeds starts, worm bed, and garden activities) takes place all year long. As children work together to create, maintain and enjoy their school garden, they are exposed to concepts such as symbiotic relationships of plants and animals, solar energy, plant lifecycles, photosynthesis, cooperation, environmental stewardship and ecological awareness.



Last December, a team of intrepid volunteers from the tax department at Exelon braved a brutally cold day to re-build the greenhouse that moved with us to our new home in Logan Square from our former campus in Buena Park. We are so grateful for their hard work since, with the planting season now underway, the preschoolers are getting the seed starts and other plants that have been nurtured in the greenhouse into the ground on schedule – something that would not have been possible without that effort. Our students learned about seeds and growth, plant ecology and so much more. And in turn the vegetables the children raise will be featured in snacks they help create as well as produce that they will "sell" in the regular parents' farmers market.

This year will also feature the creation of a new butterfly/hummingbird garden in the front of the Heineman Center building that should be in full bloom by mid-July.

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




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
Dr. Martha Heineman Pieper's new children's book wins multiple prizes

Pieper, M.D., has published her second children's story book and it is winning numerous awards and prizes. Jilly's Terrible Temper Tantrums: And How She Outgrew Them is an endearing story about Jilly, a happy little kangaroo, who has a series of Terrible Temper Tantrums that her parents lovingly help her through. The prestigious Mom's Choice Gold Award for Picture Books cites the book for its message that helps families grow emotionally, promotes good will and is inspirational and uplifting. In conferring the National Parenting Publications Award, NAPPA Director Elena Epstein said, "Helping our kids manage and better articulate their feelings is a critical part of parenting and this is a delightful book to guide our children through their frustrations.
