Psychotherapist Positions

We are seeking Illinois licensed therapists for part time and full time therapist positions for our Oak Park and Logan Square offices (*Hybrid of Telehealth and In Person*).

- Offer services to clients and families of color through our It Takes a Village Program

Requirements:

- Licensed as a Clinical Psychologist, LSW/LCSW or LPC/LCPC in IL
- Some evening hours are required
- Values providing long term psychotherapy and relationship based psychotherapy
- Enjoys learning and ongoing supervision/consultation regardless of experience level

Payment Structure:

- For fully licensed therapists: Collections model (earn a percentage of fees collected) for client hours
- For LPC or LSW therapists working towards licensure: Full time fellowship opportunities that offer a competitive stipend
